Making a simple swim ladder

Using some scrap wood, a wooden dowel and some old rope. The end of the rope that attaches to the boat contain 2 snap shackles back spliced onto the rope. They clip to the jib track on the rail at the boarding gate.

Each large piece of wood (4) are grooved with a round rasp file to create a depression that the rope sits in.

The dowels are glued in and the part of the dowel that faces up is epoxied and sprinkled with sand so you do not slip.

Blowing up the photos will allow you to see the dimensions.

Storage is ½ the size of the ladder and easily fits into the lazerette.
